## FBLA Scholarship

The University of the Ozarks will offer up to two renewable \$2,500 FBLA Scholarships.

### FBLA Scholarship Criteria

- 1) Application for FBLA Scholarship (see page 2).
- 2) Minimum high school grade point average of 3.0. A copy of high school transcript(s) must accompany the Application for FBLA Scholarship.
- 3) ACT score between 24 and 26. A copy of the ACT score must accompany the Application.
- 4) Personal Essay (see page 3).
- 5) Personal Interview.

### How to renew scholarships

Scholarships are automatically renewed for students who maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA.

### Selection Process

Selection will be based on (1) the Application for FBLA Scholarship, (2) High School Grade Point Average, (3) ACT Score, (4) Personal Essay, and (5) Personal Interview. Qualified students will be asked for an interview with U of O faculty. FBLA scholarships will be awarded beginning fall 2006.

## How to Apply

Interested students must submit the (1) Application for FBLA Scholarship, (2) copy of high school transcript, (3) copy of ACT score, and (4) personal essay to the University of the Ozarks Admissions Office. The U of O Admissions Office will contact students who qualify for a personal interview.

Applications will be received on an ongoing basis until August 18, 2006.
