By completing chapter activities, Outstanding Chapters will receive Certificates of Recognition for the chapter and ribbons for delegates attending the 2024 Collegiate National Leadership Conference (NLC). Ten local chapters will be awarded plaques at the NLC based on their submissions. All activities must be completed by May 1 to receive recognition at the NLC.

OUTSTANDING CHAPTER TRACKER

Develop your chapter S.M.A.R.T. goals, 300 programming, and action plan for the academic year (upload planning document). POINTS Have at least two members register to attend the Career Connections Conference 200 in Des Moines or Charlotte (upload **POINTS** registration confirmation).

Conduct at least four chapter meetings (upload meeting agendas).

Plan & execute a membership recruitment activity open to all students on your campus; 200 recruit two new members to your local **POINTS** chapter (upload recruitment activity planning documents).

Collaborate with a department on your college/university campus on one event open to all students (upload planning document).

200 **POINTS** Host an online or in-person Know Before You Go (KBYG) workshop for those who are 100 attending the CCC in Des Moines or **POINTS** Charlotte (upload workshop slides).

Host a panel to learn about career paths across various industries; invite business & industry professionals (upload names of participants).

Develop and implement a social media strategy for your chapter's social media platforms (upload social media calendar screenshot).

Develop a chapter budget and fundraising plan for your chapter. Participate in one fundraiser activity for a charity of your choosing (upload planning document with money raised).

Register a team for the Stock Market Game 100 (upload registration confirmation). **POINTS**

Host an information session with a local high school about FBLA Collegiate (upload meeting confirmation with High School adviser/chapter contact info).

Promote your chapter at a campus-wide student organization fair or similar event on 100 your campus (upload a picture at the fair). POINTS

Host or participate in a community service project on your campus or within your community in which more than a quarter of your chapter members participate (upload a POINTS group photo of those in attendance).

Create and deliver a quick presentation about FBLA Collegiate in one of your classes; coordinate with your instructor (Upload name of the course and faculty member).

Have at least four members earn the Silver level of the Collegiate Excellence Awards.
